**1. Average Cycle Times**

I-485: 6.5 Months

N-400: 6 Months

In an attempt to bring down the N-400 cycle time, they are going to be scheduling Saturday interviews in July and August.

**2. Parole-in-Place**

Parole-in-Place applicants should be receiving biometrics notices within 10 days of application. You may contact Stacey Summers if you have not received the notice.

If eligibility needs to be determined in an interview setting, the notice of interview will state that an eligibility determination needs to be made. Attorneys are welcome at the interview.

**3. I-751 Delays**

If a case has been pending for over a year, it would be considered delayed. If there is an urgent need for adjudication, let the District Office know and they can request the file for adjudication.

**4. Reschedule Requests**

Wait at least 45 days before following up on a reschedule request. You will not receive a response noting that the request was approved. The response will be a new interview notice if approved.
